Save Chapter 503, No Deal to Repeal

In 1982, 67% of voters approved a referendum that set commonsense, responsible preconditions for the construction of new nuclear power reactors in Massachusetts. The law, Chapter 503 of the Acts of 1982, passed after human error caused a partial core meltdown at Three Mile Island, Unit 2 reactor in Middletown, PA in 1979.

Chapter 503 instituted needed guardrails, including a statewide vote where the people could decide their energy future. The law requires both houses of the legislature to certify that a fully operational repository for nuclear waste is in place, along with effective evacuation plans, before putting the question to the voters: “Shall we run the risk and build another nuclear power reactor in our State?”

Now these guardrails are getting in Governor Healey’s way. So, she recently asked the legislature to repeal the 1982 voter-approved referendum. This strikes at the heart of our democracy and the safety of our environment.

Six lawmakers are going to decide whether to repeal Chapter 503 and promote the construction of new nukes in Massachusetts, threatening us with more broken promises, more radiation, more rate-hikes, and more radioactive waste.

Hold The Line On Democracy and Safe Energy!

These six lawmakers—three from the Senate, three from the House—are meeting in a closed sessions to decide our energy future. Don’t let them repeal the guardrails that protect us.
